A very good morning to all of you!

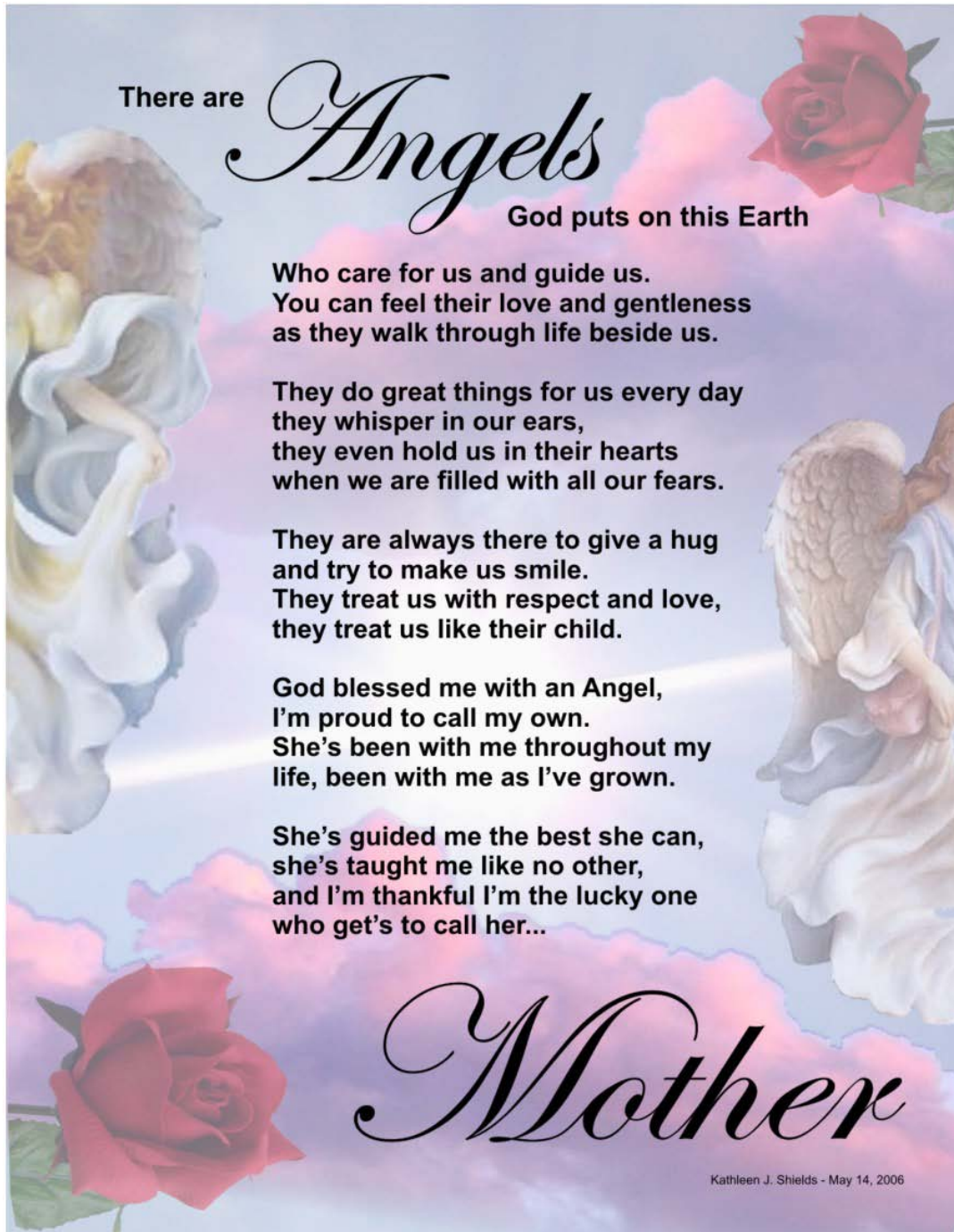
We have gathered here today to pay tribute to the most important and lovable person, the Mother.
