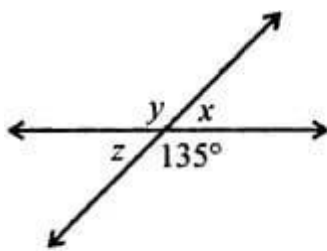

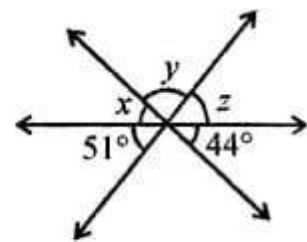

SCIENCE

I. Q1 to 3 to be done in science notebook.

If you were Tanya, how would you use the scientific method to find out why clothes dry faster in some conditions? Write the steps you would follow.

2. The science teacher divided students into two groups to grow bean plants. One group watered the plants daily while the other watered them only once a week. After two weeks, the plants looked very different.

Why is it important in science to compare results carefully before making conclusions? What could happen if scientists make conclusions without proper observations?

3. During a visit to his grandparents' village, Dev saw mangoes ripening naturally on trees. Nearby, workers were constructing a new road using machines and cement. From the above, mention them as natural and man-made change? Can a change be both useful and harmful at the same time? Explain with reasons. Write 5 natural and man-made changes in the surrounding.
